

100th Day Service Project

Topic: Helping our Community - 100 Days 100 Ways

Objectives:

Students will collect 100 items to support local shelters for the 100th day of school.
Students will count, organize and pack the items to be delivered to the agency
Students will thank the donors that help provide them with the items

Materials Needed:

Chart to track progress towards goal
Boxes to hold the items
Thank You cards
Party supplies (optional)

Assessment:

Reflection Exit Ticket

Structure / Activity:

- First, introduce the idea of the project. If it's age appropriate talk about how domestic violence affects families and the impact it can have on someone's safety. Take some time to brainstorm about the idea of home and safety.
- Work through the slideshow and determine what item you'd like to collect for your project. Some ideas: blankets, towels, pillows, socks, toothbrushes, cleaning products or stuffed animals (please note: all soft good donations MUST be new).
- Brainstorm with students about the different ways they could go about seeking these donations.
- Get going! Be clear about where donations will be stored and when they last day to donate is! They may want to make posters, write letters or write a script for a presentation in the cafeteria or a morning announcement. Let the students lead the way.
- On the 100th day, count your items and celebrate! Have a dance party, do 100 jumping jacks or enjoy some popcorn!
